Form Competition is open to any AAU, USAT, or WTF Forms.

All 1st Dan Black belts must perform Koryo, 2nd Dan Keumgang, 3rd Dan Taebak Taegeuk and Palgwe and WTF forms will compete against each other. All other Black Belt & colored belt forms will be bracketed in the creative forms division.

Grand Champion Trophies for: Black Belt Form age 18 and older (Male and Female), Black Belt ages 14-17 (Male and Female), Black Belt ages 6-13, ages 5-11 low belt (white belt thru orange belt), ages 5-11 high belt (green belt thru red belt), ages 12-17 low belt (white belt thru orange belt), ages 12-17 high belt (green belt thru red belts), this is subject to change by director.

Breaking will follow the Forms competition. (This is a Medal Event)

All will receive a medal. (One 1st, One 2nd, the rest 3rd) If for some reason you are only doing breaking. You can trade in your medal for a trophy.

Please see me if you do not receive a Trophy.

Awards for Forms are as follows: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers will receive a high quality customized Trophy. Every competitor will receive a trophy.
